BIB ALLOCATION

Date: Sunday 10 November 2019
Time: 6.45am – 9.30am
Location: Rosebud Primary School, Point Nepean Rd, Rosebud - see map below

ROLE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• On arrival report to Information area and collect volunteer lanyard• Report to Bib Allocation Team Leader in the Bibs Allocation area• Receive brief given by Bib Allocation Team Leader• Entrants begin arriving at 7am• A check list in bib number order will be on each table, listing bib number, name, team/family name, gender – highlight entries as they are collected• Any changes need to be recorded on the separate amendments sheet) – ie sometimes gender is recorded wrong in the entry - and given to Tomato Timing who will be set up in the hall
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- An alphabetical order listing will also be available to look up if the entrant does not have their bib number
- Separate line for Teams and Families
 - Their bibs will be individually enveloped and placed in a box ready for one person to collect
 - Highlight team/family on the checklist when collected and record full name of person collecting the team/family entries
 - If they come to the regular line, they can still collect their entries
- Up to 5 lines for pre-registered entrants to collect their race packs (each line will have a bib number range – ie 1000 – 1100, 1101 to 1200)
 - If the entrant can't be found and they insist they have entered, it is likely they didn't complete the payment process (or it bounced), so ask Event Manager or Tomato Timing to look up
 - If an entrant hasn't registered online, send them to the Registration area for manual entry or they can enter online using their own device



	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Pre-registered entrants give their bib number to Bib Allocation volunteer to look up• Locate the bib<ul style="list-style-type: none">• If the bib is missing, get an unallocated bib and record the new number on the amendments list• No dogs are allowed at Seawinds Gardens, as it is a state park, so if anyone turns up with a dog please inform them their dog cannot participate• Advise entrants to go across to the beach side of Jetty Rd to assemble while waiting for the race to commence<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Cross using the traffic lights- Line up with runners in the front, then walkers, then walkers with prams• The race must commence at 8.30am• Pack down and clean up after the race commences
